Greetings to our New Lebanon neighbors!

We are just looking to take a moment of your time to introduce ourselves to you. We are the members of the stone church located across from the High School on State Route 22 in New Lebanon. Our name is Church of Our Saviour.

We are a church of the Episcopal Church of the United States. Our parish began worshipping in the valley in 1772. We then moved to our current structure in 1881 after completion of the construction of the church (which actually began in 1872). It is listed as a national historic site. Inside you will find antique stain glass windows and traditional Gothic construction. Attached to it is our rectory, the home of our priest, which was built around 1890. Additional construction included the parish hall and office in the 20th century.

Our Sunday services follow the Episcopal 1972 Book of Common Prayer. Typically, on the first and third Sundays of the month our service includes hymns accompanied by either our organ or a piano played by members of the congregation. After the service we have a coffee hour in the parish hall, with light breakfast fare. In addition, we have a Bible Study that meets one evening each week. We are on Facebook and air our services live every Sunday. We also have a link to attend services or the Bible Study via Zoom.

We like to think of ourselves not as a "museum of saints", but instead as a "hospital for sinners". We each of us are far from perfect and so we are accepting of the same in each of us. We come together to sometimes work through that brokenness with mutual support and sometimes we just simply are "there" for each other quietly yet lovingly. We openly welcome Christians of all denominations.

We are active in the community with numerous forms of outreach, including the New Lebanon school backpack program, the food pantry, community picnics, blessing of animals, Christmas toys and cash donations for needy families, and even the Halloween Trunk or Treat program.
