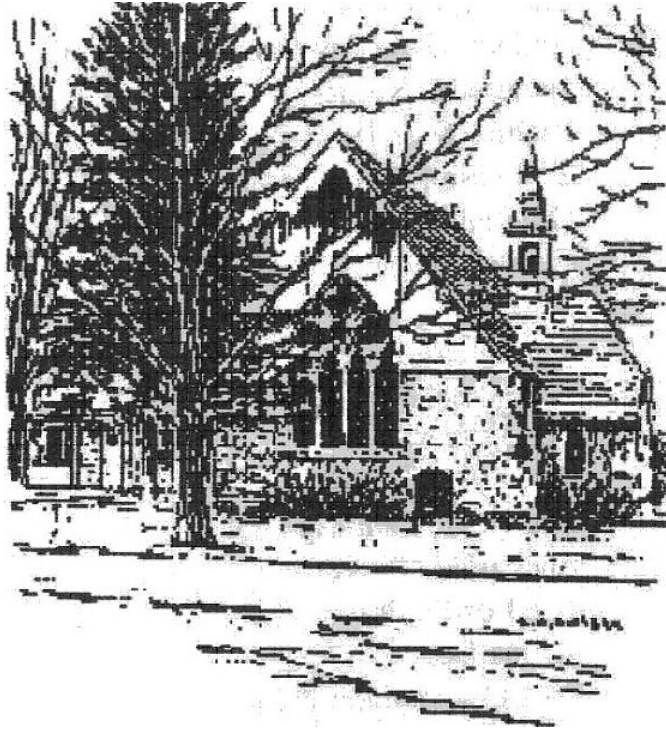

It's a desktop calendar that I buy every year, called Church Signs. Sometimes I rip off each day and sometimes a week or more goes by before I can catch up which is what I was doing.

The interesting thing about the calendar is that it always has an appropriate saying that I can relate to or I file it away for another day. I've kept quite a few of the days that I refer to during the year. And there is one that I cherish more than the rest. It's from 28 March, not even the Ides but the words are as memorable.

"God is too big to fit in one religion."

The message says it all. Sometimes it seems like we're being told that we are exclusive – that this is the only way. But God tells us to love **EVERYONE** not just the ones who look like us or believe like us or talk like us or ...whatever else – I know you understand. It says to me that we can't fit God into our tiny, little world – He is just **TOO** big! Aren't we fond of saying: "God is good – All the time! All the time, God is good?" And we know He is good to **EVERYONE!**

My calendar gives me things to really think about. As another calendar page says, "**May the hand of a friend always be near you!**" I love that one as I immediately think of my family of friends at Church of Our Saviour. That's what we're all about. Being a friend to our parish family, our communities, the nation and extending our love to everyone? I sure hope so as that is what God tells me to do – be a friend. Not judge just be there for anyone.

Can you imagine what other messages I get from my Church Signs calendar? It is a wonderful journey as I walk along with God. I really do believe He sends me messages – I do read them and think about them lots. As I frequently say: one thing I know in my heart, in my brain, and in my soul, God loves us, **EVERYONE!**
